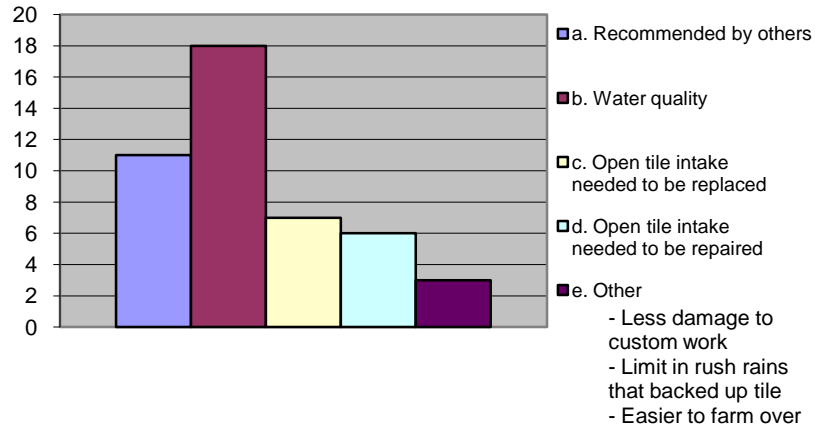

 - Easier to farm over

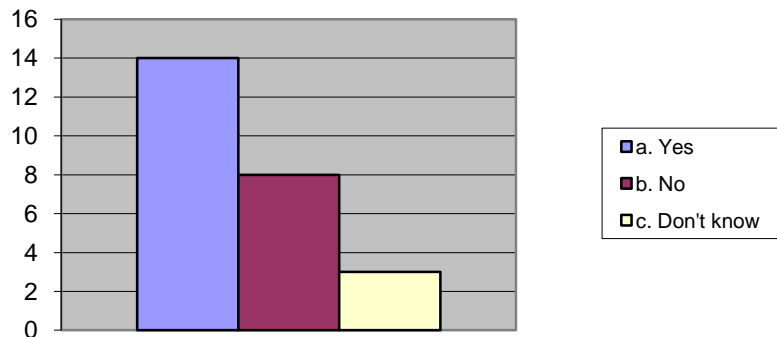
Why did you decide to include rock inlets in your farming operation?

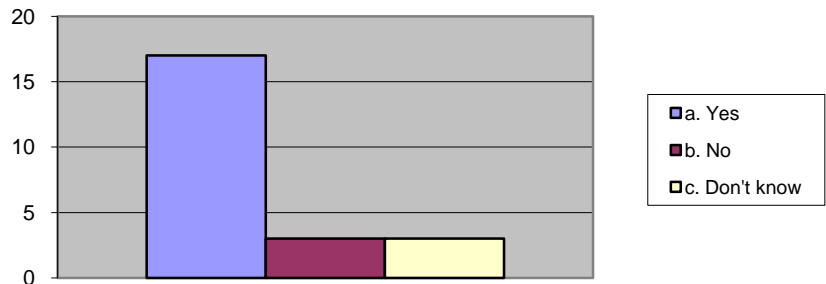
Do you take your equipment through the rock inlet?

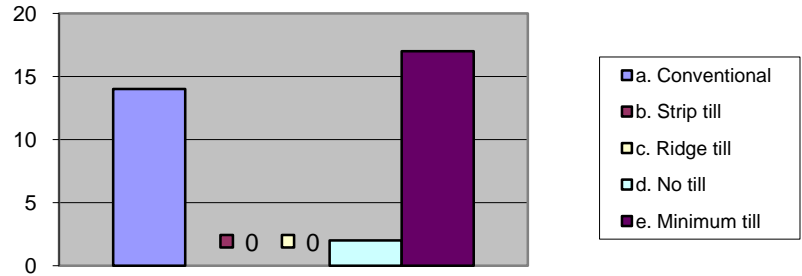

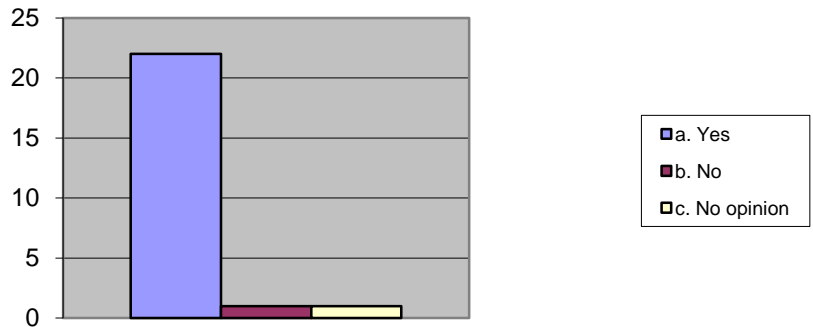
Which would best describe your current tillage practice?

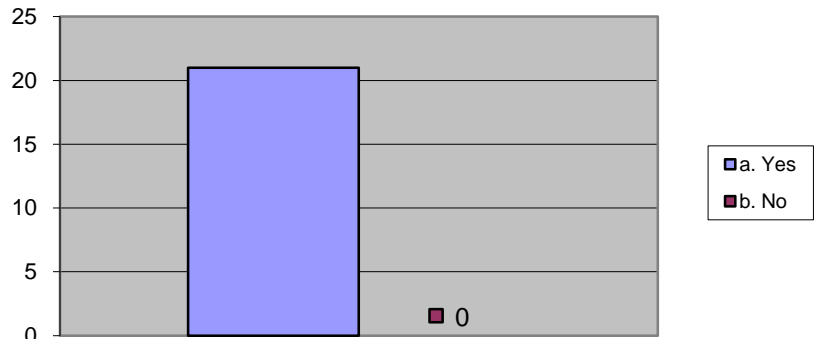
Should the HLWD continue to provide rock inlet cost-share?

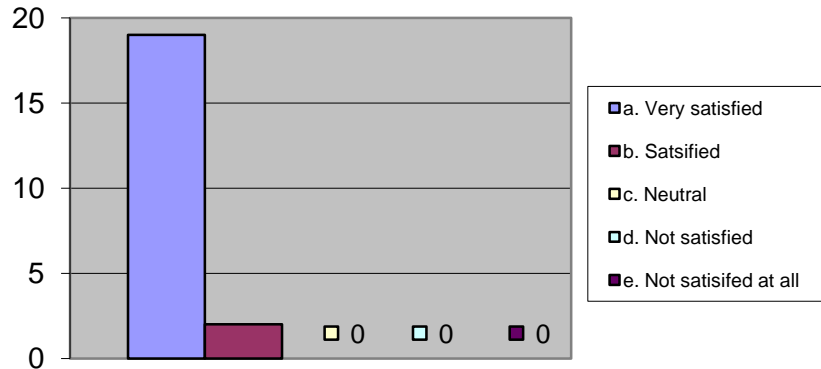

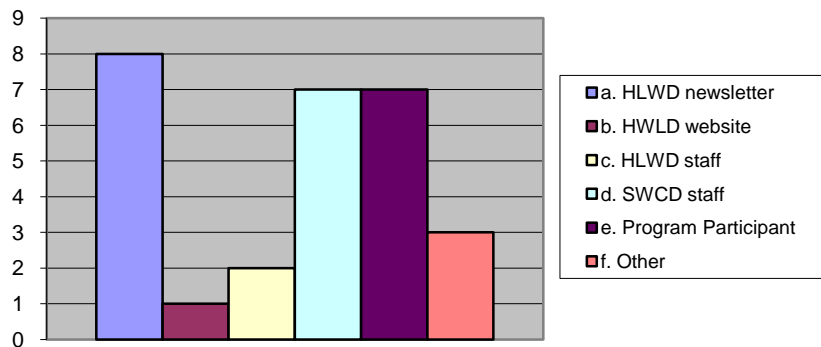
How satisfied are you with the rock inlets installed on your property?
